1. Please read and understand all relevant information carefully, including manuals, documents, training calendars, and official announcements related to this training, to ensure that you fully benefit from the program.
2. The evaluation and grading consist of a total of 100 points, divided as follows:
 - (1) 30 points – Theoretical training (watching videos and submitting all assignments). Must obtain the full 30 points to pass.
 - (2) 30 points – Seminar participation (attend both days for a total of 12 hours and submit assignments). Must achieve at least 18 points to pass.
 - (3) 30 points – Post-training test (final). Must achieve at least 18 points to pass.
 - (4) 5 points – Submission of teaching video (VDO) and lesson plan (PDF) reflecting the module's competencies. Must achieve at least 3 points to pass.
 - (5) 5 points – Attitude and behavior (assessed by the class teacher). Must achieve at least 3 points to pass.
 - (6) Passing criteria: Participants must pass all five components (1–5) to successfully complete the training.
3. During the theoretical training phase, participants must meet with the class teacher at least four (4) times.
4. Participants must attend the seminar on both days, keep their cameras on, and actively participate in all activities throughout the day.
5. The final evaluation results will be determined according to the specified criteria. In case of any operational issues, the decision of the Teachers Council of Thailand Secretariat Office (Khurusapha) shall be final.
